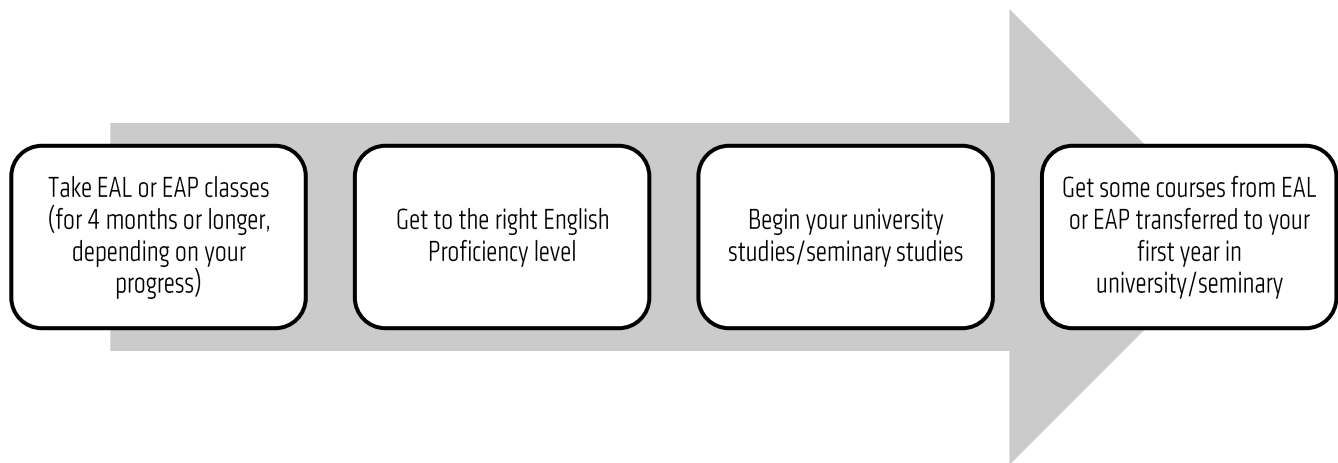




SUMMARY FOR ENGLISH AS AN ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE (EAL) OR ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES (EAP)

Fees are subject to change at any time without notice. These are estimated amounts for one semester (either September-December or January-April)

If your English proficiency test scores are lowered than the required score, you will be required to take classes through our Modern Language Institute either in the English as an Additional Language (EAL) stream or English for Academic Purposes (EAP) steam. This would add one semester (four months) or two semesters (eight months) depending on your English proficiency level. Once you get to the right proficiency level, you can start your university studies.
