The successful candidate will hold a relevant PhD and exhibit competency in the Old Testament, as well as its relationship to the New Testament and Christian theology. The ideal candidate will have relevant teaching experience, and be competent to teach courses across the curriculum, including Hebrew language courses, and to direct thesis students. Pastoral experience is desirable.
