



SUMMARY FOR FIRST YEAR STUDIES: US STUDENTS

**Fees are subject to change at any time without notice.** These are estimated amounts for one full year. Tuition may be higher depending on what courses you register for. For Aviation tuition, please refer to Aviation Fee Chart

In order to graduate on time, you must take 5 courses per semester (10 courses per year). For example, to graduate from a 4-year program, you will only graduate in 4 years if you take 10 courses per academic year. To be a full-time student, you must take 4 or 5 courses per semester.

ACADEMIC ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

If you have recently graduated from high school, and have not taken more than 18 credit hours (or 6 courses) at another university/college, you may be eligible to get an entrance scholarship based on your Grade 12 academic average (Grade 11 academic average may be considered if you apply for admission before April 1. Amount will be awarded based on the higher average). Half the amount will be applied to the Fall semester, and the other half to the Winter semester (e.g. if you get \$1,500, \$750 will be applied to your tuition for the Fall semester and \$750 will be applied to your tuition for the Winter semester)

In order to receive the scholarship, you must do the following during your first year

- Take at least 4 courses (12 credit hours) per semester
- Be in good academic standing i.e. not fail a course

After your first year, your GPA will be assessed for our Earn and Save bursary. Depending on your first year GPA at Providence University College, you can get anywhere between \$1,500 to \$2,500 for your second year.
