



SUMMARY FOR FIRST YEAR STUDIES: UNDERGRADUATE

Fees are subject to change at any time without notice. These are estimated amounts for one full year. Tuition may be higher depending on what courses you register for. For Aviation tuition, please refer to the Aviation Fee Chart

In order to graduate on time, you must take 5 courses per semester (10 courses per year). For example, to graduate from a 4-year program, you will only graduate in 4 years if you take 10 courses per academic year. To maintain a full-time student status, you must take at least 4 courses per semester, but this means it will take you longer to graduate.

If your English proficiency test scores are lowered than the required score, you will be required to take classes through our Modern Language Institute either in the English as an Additional Language (EAL) stream or English for Academic Purposes (EAP) steam. This would add one semester (four months) or two semesters (eight months) depending on your English proficiency level
