The candidate will also contribute research and scholarship as well as service to the school, their profession, religious communities, and other contexts. We seek a professor-scholar-practitioner who desires to study, teach, and learn with an attitude of free and open inquiry in an atmosphere of mutual respect and support.

EDUCATION & QUALIFICATIONS

The successful candidate will have:

- An earned doctorate in a counselling-related discipline, or currently pursuing a doctoral degree.
- Teaching experience and counselling credentials.
- An ability to work with students, faculty and staff in a collegial environment.
- A commitment to infusing Christian faith in all aspects of the role.
- Canadian Citizenship or Permanent Resident status. In accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, preference will be given to those with this status.

Rank and salary will be determined by qualifications and experience.
