POSITION OVERVIEW

Providence Theological Seminary invites applicants for a full or part-time scholar and clinician for our diverse, growing, and dynamic Counselling Psychology department. We seek a clinician-scholar who desires to teach and learn with an attitude of free and open inquiry in an atmosphere of mutual respect and support.

Responsibilities will include academic and clinical teaching as well as advising students in the counselling programs. The successful candidate will provide clinical expertise within the context of counselling practicums as well as be able to teach a variety of introductory as well as upper level counselling and psychology courses. They will bring a depth of Biblical integration into all aspects of their teaching. In addition, they will provide service to the Providence community, the counselling profession, their religious community, and other contexts.

Required to be a resident faculty member on the Otterburne campus. This may require the successful applicant to relocate to the Otterburne area (e.g., Winnipeg, Steinbach, surrounding communities).

- Teaching experience at a graduate level
- Post-graduation clinical experience
