POSITION OVERVIEW

Providence University College invites applications for one of several part-time positions as a **Sessional Instructor**, beginning **September 2025 in Otterburne**. These positions are open for individuals with expertise in one or more of the following areas:

Courses in Otterburne are offered in four-month semesters (September – December; January – April). Instructors can apply to teach one or both semesters.
